

GENERAL RENTAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR VEHICLE RENTAL

Bravira Cars AB (Effective from 2026-06-25)

These general terms and conditions apply to the rental of vehicles from Bravira Cars AB ("the Lessor") to the customer ("the Lessee", "HT").

By booking or accepting a rented vehicle, the Lessee approves the terms below.

1. Use of the Vehicle

- **1.1** A copy of this rental agreement must be kept in the vehicle throughout the rental period and be presented upon request to the police, customs, or any other person acting on behalf of the Lessor.
- **1.2** The vehicle may only be used for normal use within Sweden by the Lessee. Only drivers who have been approved in writing by the Lessor may operate the vehicle. The Lessee is responsible for ensuring that all drivers hold a valid driver's license and proper entitlement.
- **1.3** Driving outside Sweden may only occur with written permission from the Lessor. If the Lessee attempts to take the vehicle out of the country without permission, the right to use the vehicle terminates immediately, and the police, customs, or the Lessor's representatives have the right to impound the vehicle. The Lessee is responsible for all costs and damages incurred by the Lessor if the vehicle is taken outside Sweden or other non-approved countries.
- **1.4** The Lessee may not rent out or lend the vehicle to a third party. Transporting people or goods for payment is prohibited. The vehicle must not be used to tow, push, or otherwise move other vehicles or objects. Use in competitions, motorsport events, or similar activities is strictly prohibited.

2. Rent and Delayed Payment

- **2.1** The rental amount is stated on the first page of the rental agreement. The Lessee is responsible for ensuring the rent is paid on time. If the rent is to be invoiced to another natural or legal person, the Lessee remains jointly and severally liable for payment.
- **2.2** The Lessor has the right to demand a deposit or advance payment. Post-billing may occur for costs arising during or in direct connection with the rental period. Costs for fuel, oil, washer fluid, and other consumables are not included in the rent.
- **2.3** For invoicing, the Lessor has the right to charge an invoicing fee of SEK 250 incl. VAT. In the event of non-payment, default interest will be charged corresponding to the Riksbank's reference rate plus 15 percentage points, as well as a statutory reminder fee of SEK 450 incl. VAT.

3. Delayed or Cancelled Delivery

- **3.1** The Lessor shall provide the vehicle at the agreed time. If this cannot occur, the Lessee is entitled to a rental reduction corresponding to the delay. If the delay is of

material significance, the Lessee has the right to terminate the agreement.

- **3.2** However, the Lessee does not have the right to terminate the agreement if the Lessor immediately offers an equivalent replacement vehicle without major inconvenience to the Lessee.
- **3.3** The Lessor is not responsible for delays due to circumstances beyond their control (Force Majeure) that could not reasonably have been foreseen or avoided. Compensation is not paid for indirect losses or loss of business.

4. Care of the Vehicle

- **4.1** The Lessee must take good care of the vehicle and ensure it is used in accordance with the instructions in the vehicle's manual. The Lessee is responsible for checking the oil level, coolant, tire pressure, and ensuring that the correct fuel or charging is used. The Lessor has the right to charge the Lessee for all costs arising from incorrect handling.
- **4.2** For monthly rentals and driving distances exceeding 1,250 km, the Lessee must ensure that prescribed servicing is carried out at a workshop designated by the Lessor. The service cost will be reimbursed by the Lessor. If servicing is missed due to the Lessee's negligence, the Lessee will be charged SEK 200 per 10 km (SEK 20 per km) that exceeds the service interval.
- **4.3** The Lessor has the right to inspect the vehicle during the rental period if there is reasonable cause to suspect improper use or an increased risk of depreciation.
- **4.4** Smoking or transporting animals in the vehicle is not permitted. A cleaning fee will be charged in the event of a violation. The vehicle must not be overloaded, driven off-road, on unplowed roads, or within other high-risk areas. The Lessee must park and lock the vehicle securely.

5. Actions in the Event of Faults, Damage, or Theft

- **5.1** The Lessee must immediately inform the Lessor of any faults, damage, or theft of the vehicle and follow the vehicle's warning systems. The Lessor will then inform the Lessee of what measures should be taken.
- **5.2** In insurance cases, the Lessee must promptly submit a complete damage report to the Lessor. If the vehicle or keys are stolen, or if an unknown person has caused damage, a police report must be filed at the place of the incident and a copy sent to the Lessor. Failure to follow these routines means the Lessee becomes fully liable for the damage incurred by the Lessor.
- **5.3** The Lessee is responsible for ensuring that the deductible (excess) to the insurer is paid in accordance with the terms in section 9.

6. Lessor's Liability for Breakdowns or Damage

- **6.1** The Lessor is responsible for ensuring that the vehicle is in a roadworthy and functional condition at the time of handover.
- **6.2** If a fault or breakdown occurs during the rental period due to the vehicle's condition, the Lessee has the right to a rental reduction or, if the fault is material, the right to terminate the agreement. However, the agreement may not be terminated if the Lessor repairs the vehicle or provides an equivalent replacement vehicle without delay.
- **6.3** In the event of breakdowns caused by traffic accidents, vehicle damage, or theft, the agreement ceases to apply only after the Lessee has contacted the Lessor and filed any necessary police reports and damage reports.

7. Violations of Traffic and Parking Regulations

- **7.1** The Lessee is fully responsible for all costs incurred by the Lessor in its capacity as the vehicle owner, including parking fines, traffic offenses, road, congestion, and toll fees, as well as overloading fees. However, this does not apply if the violation is demonstrably due to a fault in the vehicle that the Lessee did not know about or should not have known about.
- **7.2** If the Lessor is forced to pay or administer such fees, the Lessor has the right to charge the Lessee for the fee plus an administration cost of SEK 500 incl. VAT. For reporting to authorities, for example in the case of speeding offenses, an additional SEK 2,000 will be charged.

8. Lessee's Liability for Damage or Loss

- **8.1** The Lessee is responsible for all damage that occurs to the vehicle during the rental period, including total loss, with the exception of normal wear and tear. The Lessee is not responsible for damage if an identified counterparty or their insurance company fully compensates the cost. If the Lessee is a consumer and can prove that the damage was not caused by negligence, no liability applies.
- **8.2** The Lessee must immediately report damage to the Lessor and submit a complete damage report within two weeks, or upon return if this occurs earlier. The Lessee is obliged to actively cooperate in investigations, insurance cases, and police reports.

9. Liability for Damages and Risk Reduction (Deductible)

- **9.1** The Lessee's liability for damages and deductible in the event of damage or loss is based on the applicable insurance terms. For each damage incident, the following distribution applies:
 - **a)** For damages where the total damage cost amounts to a maximum of SEK 200,000, the Lessee is fully responsible for and required to pay the entire damage amount up to this cap.
 - **b)** For extensive damages where the total damage cost exceeds SEK 200,000, the Lessee is required to pay a deductible corresponding to 30% of the total damage cost for each respective damage.

This liability and deductible system includes, but is not limited to: vehicle damage, traffic accidents, fire damage, theft, glass damage, towing, height clearance damages, and unauthorized driving abroad.

- **9.2** Drivers under the age of 24 will be charged a special young driver surcharge of SEK 8,500 incl. VAT.

10. Mitigation of Damage

- **10.1** Both the Lessee and the Lessor are obliged to take reasonable measures to mitigate any damage that has occurred. A party that fails to do so shall itself bear the costs that could otherwise have been avoided.

11. Return of the Vehicle

- **11.1** The vehicle must be returned to the agreed place and time, in the same condition as upon handover, apart from normal wear and tear. The Lessor and Lessee shall, if

- possible, jointly inspect the vehicle upon return.
- **11.2** If the vehicle is abnormally dirty, neglected, or damaged, the Lessor has the right to charge reasonable costs for restoration and reconditioning.
 - **11.3** In the event of a delayed return that is not due to the Lessor, rent will be charged according to the applicable rate, and the Lessee is obliged to compensate for all costs to restore or retrieve the vehicle. It is explicitly forbidden to use the vehicle after the rental period has expired.

12. Lessor's Right to Terminate the Agreement

- **12.1** The Lessor has the right to terminate the agreement with immediate effect if:
 - **a)** The Lessee does not make payments on time and fails to pay after a reminder.
 - **b)** The vehicle is handled in a way that involves a significant risk of depreciation or serious damage.
 - **c)** The Lessee commits another material breach of contract.
 - **d)** The Lessee or another approved driver loses their driver's license or entitlement.
- **12.2** Upon termination, the Lessor has the right to immediately repossess the vehicle at the Lessee's expense and charge for the costs arising in connection with the repossession.

13. Processing of Personal Data (GDPR)

- **13.1** Bravira Cars AB processes personal data in accordance with the applicable General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) for the administration of rental agreements, payments, claims handling, and fulfillment of legal obligations. The Lessee is responsible for informing any co-drivers about this personal data processing.
- **13.2** Lessees who breach these terms may be registered on the *Biluthyrarna Sverige* (The Swedish Car Rental Association) information list, which is used by rental companies within the industry to prevent damage and fraud. The list is administered in accordance with the Credit Information Act and with the permission of the Swedish Privacy Protection Authority (IMY).
